To this end we have introduced working practices and reviewed our supply chain to ensure we have a uniform approach to such environmental matters.

Below is a list of what we have implemented to date, and we are open to suggestions and advice to improve.

1/ All BMK company owned/leased **vans** are of the most efficient and environmentally friendly EURO6 engine designs.

When suitable battery vans become available in load capacity and milage range we will adjust over our fleet over to these.

2/ BMK have 2 fully electric company vehicles which transport personnel.

3/ All BMK company vans are registered for waste transport under the Waste (England and Wales) regulations 2011.

4/ Personnel are encouraged (where possible and practical) to use public transport not only from home to site but between sites, including hire of Bikes /E scooters. To assist in the encouragement of this the company reimburses staff with all costs of such travel.

5/ All company waste is handled by our Waste partner Lawmans Ltd who are fully accredited with SKArating/BREEAM/fitwell and most UK accreditations. A full waste environmental report is available on larger projects which shows the impressive lengths of recycling achieved.
